Over Spring Break all five of us piled into our car to begin a college tour for our twins, Talia and Zach. It is hard to believe that they are 17 years old. Harder still to imagine them beginning a new adventure on their own. They have not only had the comfort of family their entire lives, but they have always been identified as a twin. As we walked the beautiful tree-lined paths of so many colleges and universities, I thought about the fact that their undergraduate experience will truly be a new start for them on so many levels.

College campuses are universes unto themselves. It was incredible to hear the enthusiastic student tour guides introduce themselves, state their majors (often double majors AND minors) and imagine my own children, perhaps someday, guiding a tour group and introducing themselves to wide-eyed future students and families.

Each campus had its own sense of spirit and community. I have to say it almost made me want to travel back in time and do it all over again..... almost....

In one year exactly, my twins will be 18. I cannot help but reflect on the Hebrew, mystical symbol of this number. Chai. Life. At 18, God willing, my children will be beginning a new life.
