Hebrew with Rabbi Berg, April 10 & 24

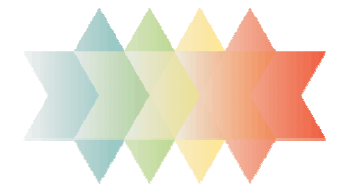
In Nisan (April 5th - May 4th), we will learn about the lives of Egyptian Jews.
