# Light From Within

The street that I grew up on was magical. Summer memories of neighborhood kids playing together each night before we were called in for dinner flood through my mind. Our house, from the outside at least. appeared stark in comparison. No experience of being a Jew. In electric lights beamed a steady red-green glow from before Thanksgiving until after the New Hanukah was miniscule in Year. But inside! Inside there were Hanukah decorations of blue and silver flanking the windows. Our menorah sat atop tinfoil so that the wax from the drip on the wooden table. We had them that made them special. Like many kids during the holiday season, my brother and I would wake up very early, run down to the basement and play with the new racetrack and cars set we received the night before. much to our dismay, couldn't effectively move ideas forward). Together, we will achieve success.


Once this meeting with Kathy has passed, I will have more information about our path forward.






