News From The Pesident

It's hard to believe that 5773 is almost complete. So much has happened at Temple Beth David this past year I could not capture it in a "year in review" that would not exceed the page limit for the Bulletin. So, I will touch upon two key topics: Clergy and Collaboration

Clergy:

Midway through 5773, we learned that Rabbi Berg would need to take a medical leave of absence, only to then learn that this would evolve into permanent medical disability. We continue to wish Rabbi Berg a *refuah shlema*. Some say that the Yiddish word *b'sheret* means "fated." It was fate that Rabbi Smookler would move to Rochester in January and be available to become our rabbi. She has brought ruach and spirited divrei torah to our Shabbat mornings, engaged us in community service and supported our members during illness, during good times and as part of lifecycle events.

I hope you can join us on Sunday, Sept. 15 at 2 p.m. to help decorate the sukkah and enjoy an informal conversation about temple life, within and out of our building. As president, I receive phone calls and emails and enjoy face

-to-face conversations about the happenings at temple. This conversation will help us prepare for the Congregational Meeting on Sunday, November 3, from 10-11:30 a.m. The congregation will have an opportunity to vote for members nominated to the Executive Board and Board of Trustees, as well as hear updates about the congregation at the Annual Meeting. While the Board of Trustees voted to hire Rabbi Smookler during Rabbi Berg's medical leave, our Bylaws require a congregational vote, which will happen at the meeting in November.

Collaboration:

Many of you have heard that "we are merging with Beth El." That is NOT the case. We are collaborating with each other, seeking and implementing ways that can serve the needs of Conservative Jews in Rochester. During this past year, we have collaborated for religious services, holiday celebrations, and for Religious School, Men's Club and Sisterhood. We have a small committee with equal representation from Beth David and Beth El, as well as representatives from BHBI and Beth Am which has met monthly for about six months.

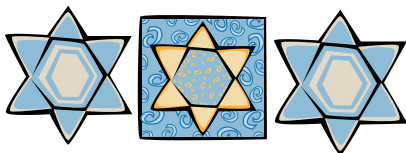
I think of you often and my prayer for you is that you may be blessed

Our committee applied for and received a grant from the Farash Foundation to study how we move this collaboration forward in a meaningful way that respects our individual histories (without handcuffing ourselves) and looks forward to serving the Conservative community in a meaningful, forward-thinking way. What we do know is that the historic synagogue model that both congregations are

based on needs to be updated to meet the needs of Conservative Jews today. USCJ is looking at our process, which may serve as a model for other communities. You will hear more during 5774 and be invited to participate in meetings/events that further the steps of the collaboration. It is my sincere hope that you participate in these future steps.

So, these two topics barely scratch the surface of what has happened at Beth David during 5773. Thank you to all of our members and staff who have made the year joyous and sweet.

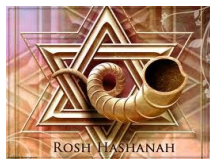

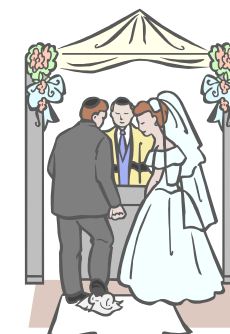

Enjoy this delicious recipe for Majestic and Moist Honey Cake (enjoy responsibly!)



3 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
1 tablespoon baking powder
1 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
4 teaspoons ground cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
1/2 teaspoon ground allspice
1 cup vegetable oil
1 cup honey
1 1/2 cups granulated sugar
1/2 cup brown sugar
3 large eggs at room temperature
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup warm coffee
1/2 cup fresh orange juice
1/4 cup rye or whiskey
1/2 cup slivered or sliced almonds (optional)

Fits in three loaf pans, two 9-inch square or round cake pans, one 9 or 10 inch tube or bundt cake pan, or one 9 by 13 inch sheet cake. I made mine in two full-size loaf pans plus two miniature ones.

Preheat oven to 350°F. Generously grease pan(s) with non-stick cooking spray. For tube or angel food pans, line the bottom with lightly greased parchment paper, cut to fit.

In a large bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, cloves and allspice. Make a well in the center, and add oil, honey, white sugar, brown sugars, eggs, vanilla, coffee or tea, orange juice and rye or whiskey, if using. (If you measure your oil before the honey, it will be easier to get all of the honey out.)

Using a strong wire whisk or in an electric mixer on slow speed, stir together well to make a thick, well-blended batter, making sure that no ingredients are stuck to the bottom.

Spoon batter into prepared pan(s). Sprinkle top of cake(s) evenly with almonds, if using. Place cake pan(s) on two baking sheets, stacked together (this will ensure the cakes bake properly with the bottom baking faster than the cake interior and top). Bake until cake tests done, that is, it springs back when you gently touch the cake center. For angel and tube cake pans, this will take 60 to 75 minutes, loaf cakes, about 45 to 55 minutes. For sheet style cakes, baking time is 40 to 45 minutes.

Let cake stand fifteen minutes before removing from pan.
