From the Desk of the Rabbi Rabbi Rachel Smookler

Missiles in my Purse

This past summer, our 16 year old twins, Talia and Zach were in Israel. As I try to look ahead towards the New Year 5775, I look back on my experiences of July and August and pray for peace in the Middle East. I was asked by an online publication if I would write my reaction to having our kids in Israel this past summer. What was it like? Was there ever a time that you wanted them to cut the trip short and send the kids home? Were you in communication with your kids while they were there? In this article, entitled "Missiles in My Purse," I try to recreate how I felt on any given day for the five weeks they were in Israel. We were concerned for the kids on the trip and we were concerned for all Israelis whose lives were put in jeopardy, all the IDF soldiers who were called up, and for the innocent loss of life both in Gaza and Israel.

There it goes. I rummage through my purse, frantic, until I feel the smooth, hard, rectangular shape of my phone. Red Alert. The App goes off. My nine-year-old daughter, Mayim, screams, "WHERE IS IT?" "The South,"

I say, with a release of breath. Still feeling terrible about the Israelis in the South....but my 16-year old twins, Mayim's brother and sister, Talia and Zach are in the North. They are constantly on the move with a group of 35 teens from the States.

The night before, my daughter called us. She was in tears. Missiles had been fired from Lebanon, rockets were pouring in from Gaza and the 25-year-old Israeli tour guide assigned to their group had been called up for reserve duty. The group leader had just announced that for safety, they would have to change their itinerary.

"Why am I here when it isn't safe?" she cried. In the middle of the night, it's not easy to answer that question. Especially when, as I am talking to her, my Red Alert App emits a continuous stream of alarms. Ahkelon, Sderot, Moatza Ezorit Eshkol, Ashdod.

I wanted to tell her that she is there to learn about her homeland to experience what Israeli life is like. My greatest fear was that she would forever feel a disconnect with

(Continued from page 1) Israel. And yet, there was a part of me that knew that this trip in Israel would forever change her life. I wanted to tell her that I was glad that she was there to see firsthand what Israelis, her people, have to deal with in a day in the life of Israel. All I could say was "We didn't know that it would be like this." And to be honest, at that moment, I was nervous too. What were we doing keeping our kids in a war zone?

Every single day for the next four weeks, I am attached to my phone. The Red Alert never rests. My phone is never more than 5 feet away from me. Once the Red Alert goes off, I touch my app that I have added to my screen that shows where, on the map of Israel,

the missile is headed. I then compare this to the kids' itinerary. They are safe this time.

I rummage through my purse. We are in a refurbished home goods store. People around us are not familiar with this eerie ring tone. My little one screams, "Where is it??" I look at the screen. Tel Aviv, Tel Aviv, Tel Aviv, Tel Aviv, tt repeats, mimicking the speed and the frequency of the rockets.. Mayim sees the look on my face. "Is it is the South?" she asks, holding her hands over her heart. "No," I say. "Tel Aviv."

A few hours later my daughter texts me picture of a beautiful

ring with the words of the *Shema*. I reply how beautiful it is. She texts me back. "As I was buying this ring, the sirens went off in Tel Aviv and we ran to a bomb shelter. Every time I look at this ring, I will think of that experience."

My phone wakes me up in the middle of the night. But this time it isn't from the Red Alert App. My daughter Talia, now with a host family in Modi'in, texts me a picture of herself and a female IDF officer at an Iron Dome Sight. I think this is the most amazing thing I have ever seen! A picture of her at Masada, or the Western Wall would not generate the pride I felt seeing my daughter witness yet another incredible Israeli landmark. They are safe.

News from the President

For the past 18 months Rochester area synagogue presidents have been meeting, first to plan for and write grant applications to the Farash Foundation, then to hire a consultant for one of the successful applications, and ultimately to work with the consultant. The project will hopefully lead to synagogues working together toward the goal of engagement for affiliated and unaffiliated Jews in our community.

How will community engagement impact Temple Beth David or other synagogues? In the face of declining synagogue affiliation (ie, membership), a national trend, we must look for new ways to connect people to synagogues...and not in our traditional ways of the past decades. We have to move beyond the "brick and mortar" of our buildings and worship services.

Neal Eckhaus, a member of our Board of Trustees, has been attending many of these meetings with me, and we are both excited to share with you the successes we have already achieved and more details about goals.

The multi-phase process with our consultant, Rabbi Lou Feldstein of Dynamic Change Solutions, is intentionally slow, allowing for research and analysis, team and trust building, and addressing the strengths and weaknesses of our community. Several months ago, Rabbi Feldstein interviewed synagogue presidents and rabbis, community leaders and, in parallel with existing demographic data, prepared an

overview which was reported to the Rochester Area Synagogue President's Council (RASP) in June. With the completion of Phase 1, RASP has decided to move on to Phase 2.


This next phase, now in its earliest stages, will take about a year to complete. During this, all synagogue boards and clergy will meet together at sessions in September and November, and Rabbi Feldstein will also meet with each synagogue board. These meetings will not only support the RASP process, they will include information and training that will strengthen each individual board. Combined, these meetings will lead to building a strong foundation for Phase 3, community-wide engagement activities.

Outside of this process, the RASP meetings have been a wonderful "support group" for area presidents. We all deal with membership, budgets, programming, staffing, leadership development, and more. Cause, ya know, we are more alike than we are different.

This Council and this process are a great resource for our community. I will share an update after the Fall meetings.

Howard, Sara, Sam and I wish everyone a l'shanah tovah – a good year.




