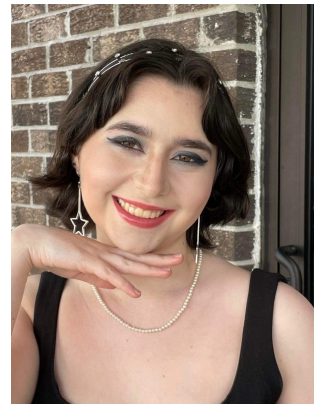

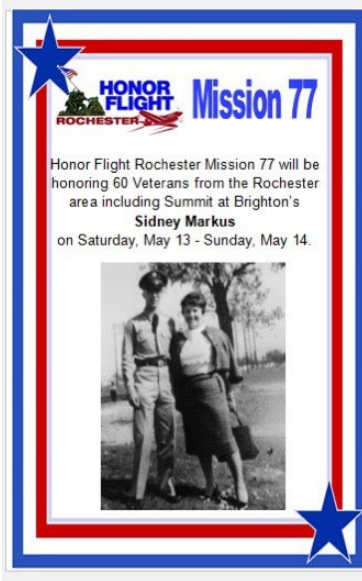

On May 20th, we read *Parashat Bemidbar* while we were in the midst of moving. In *Parashat Bemidbar*, there is a census of the 12 tribes of Israel in the desert. When camp is broken, the sanctuary is dismantled, transported and reassembled in the next location by the Levites. Torah is life. Thanks to all who organized, dismantled, transported and reassembled during the month of May.

Thank you, Rabbi Silbert, for coming up with this sentiment to put on the cake we had for dessert on May 13, our final kiddush at TBK before moving. *MiBayit LeBayit* means "from home to home" and can also mean "from temple to temple." 
